

Requests for Letters of Interest

Through Race to the Top-Early Learning Challenge, Healthcentric Advisors in collaboration with Screening to Succeed, is soliciting Letters of Interest from evidence-based parent education/support programs to provide evidence-based services to children birth to three years old and their families.

Goals of the Screening to Succeed Project:

Screening to Succeed supports primary-care providers in the implementation of an electronic developmental screening system for screenings at 9, 18, & 30 months, consistent with the Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis & Treatment (EPSDT) Schedule.

As part of *Screening to Succeed*, resources are available to support evidence based interventions to address the needs, identified through screening, of children birth to three years and their families. Such evidence based interventions promote parent education, early literacy, and social emotional development in response to the needs of the families in their care.

Agencies or providers who deliver evidence-based parent education/support programs may be eligible to participate. These services may be provided in an agency, in a community based setting, or co-located with in a primary care setting. Qualified providers will be compensated for their services.

If you or your agency provides evidence-based parent education/support programs and are interested in participating in *Screening to Succeed*, please submit your Letter of Interest which should include information regarding your qualifications along with the following information:

- *Organization/service name*
- *Specific program or services offered and outcomes that the program improves*
- *Ages of children served*
- *Qualifications of those providing services*
- *Agency capacity to provide services*
